## ARRIVING

**Parking** is available on Main St. in the front of the church. Two front entrances bring you directly into the sanctuary. A parking lot is located in the rear of the church building. Drive into the lot from either Main St. or Green St., and enter the church building through the doors marked **Welcome Center**. A **greeter** will welcome you and give you a Sunday bulletin and offer directions if needed. A TV monitor in the **Welcome Center** highlights church activities. You are invited to enjoy **coffee and breakfast treats** in our **Fellowship Café** located in Fellowship Hall adjacent to the Welcome Center. Fellowship Café is open from 8 a.m. to noon each Sunday.

## WORSHIP

**Two services are offered.** At **both services** the *bulletin* is the order of service that guides you through the worship experience. Please take it home with you. Here are a few tips you may find useful.

- An asterisk \* next to an entry means the congregation is asked to stand in body or spirit.
- Responsive readings are led by the worship leader who reads the lines printed in regular type. **The**

congregation responds with the lines printed in bold-face type.

- Please sign the "Friendship Pad" located on the end of the pew. Don't be shy. The minister will send you a note thanking you for joining us for worship – that's all. Nobody will show up at your door or call you unless you request it.
- Communion at Versailles Presbyterian Church is open to all. This is Christ's table and all are welcome.
- Feel free to bring a hot beverage into worship. We ask only that it has a lid.
- Wear whatever makes you comfortable. Some men wear coats and ties, others don't. Some women wear dresses and some wear slacks.

The **8:30 a.m.** contemplative service is approximately 30 minutes in length and provides a time of quiet reflection along with instrumental music and a sermon. **Communion** is offered at almost every 8:30 service. You are invited to come to the front of the church to receive the bread and juice. Hint: If you're unsure what to do, just follow the crowd.

The **10:30 a.m.** traditional service is approximately 60 minutes in length. A 130 year-old pipe organ and a baby grand piano provide music. The choir

sings most Sundays September thru May. Hymn books and Bibles are located in each pew.. The **Welcoming Moment** gives people a chance to greet each other, which we hope will make you feel welcome. **Communion** is offered usually on the first Sunday of each month and is open to all. Bread and juice will be brought to your seat. We hold them until everyone has been served, then eat and drink together.

## SUNDAY SCHOOL & NURSERY

**Christian education for children** begins at **9:15 a.m.** Children meet in the Sunday school classroom for music, Bible study and other activities. **Christian education for adults** begins at **9:15 a.m.** and meets in the large conference room off Fellowship Hall. The Pastor or volunteer teachers lead the class. A wide-range of subjects including Bible study, current events and topics pertinent to living life as a Christian are offered. The format of the class is perfect for drop-in guests. **Nursery** care is available for infants – 3 years old between **10:15 a.m. – 11:45 a.m.** Please ask the greeter to show you the way. The nursery is staffed by the church's nursery attendant and one adult volunteer. **Children's church** is offered for children ages 3 – 5th grade during the 10:30 a.m. service. At that service, children are invited to join the
